



## Trash Collection

Trash Collection for Charlesgate Village is provided by Modern Disposal.

**Collection Day is Wednesday. In the event of a holiday, collection is typically moved to Thursday.**

### **New Community Trash & Recycling Procedures...additional information is forthcoming**

Beginning in **August**, all homes at Charlesgate Village will transition to **tote-based** trash and recycling collection.

- Each unit will receive one (1) **Trash** tote and one (1) **Recycling** tote
- **Trash**: collected **weekly**
- All **waste** must fit inside **one trash tote**
  - No loose bags collected
  - No other containers may be used for trash
  - All yard debris must be placed inside the garbage tote
- **Recycling**: collected **every other week**
  - No other containers may be used for recycling
- Totes must be stored out of sight either in the garbage corrals, garages, or patios
- Totes stay with the property
- **\$75 fee applies for changes after May 31, 2026**

#### **Your Default Tote Assignment**

- **Units with garages**: 65-gallon Trash & 65-gallon Recycling
- **Units without garages**: 35-gallon Trash & 35-gallon Recycling

If this size works for you, **no action is needed.**

**Paper** Place loose in cart. Use clear plastic bags for shredded paper *ONLY*.

## Accepted:

- Vegetable & Food scraps\*(see list below of what is not accepted)
- Coffee Grounds & Tea Bags
- Cut and or dried flowers or plant materials
- Nut and egg shells



**PLEASE, NO:** Meat, chicken, or fish, dairy, oil based foods, animal waste, litter, or bedding, coconuts or coconut oil, coal, charcoal, diseased houseplants, and plastic bags. Compostable bags cannot be accepted either at this time, those are used for a different method of composting. Thank you!!!
